

NETPOULSAFE - WEBINAR ANNOUNCEMENT

On June 29th, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. Central European Time (CET) the fourth free webinar of the NetPoulSafe project will take place. In this webinar we will discuss about Less biosecurity measures implemented in Poultry meat production in Europe, why don't farmers implement it? and also on 2 supporting measures that can help to improve farm biosecurity measures: participatory approach (focus group) and Biopon Programme.

In the first part of the webinar, **Rozenn Souillard** (ANSES) will discuss first about the least biosecurity measures implemented in Poultry meat production in Europe, the reasons for non-implementation as well as the opinion on the effectiveness of the measures from the point of view of farmers, and advisors.

In the second part of the webinar **Nathalie Rousset** (ITAVI) and **Aitor Devesa** (CECAV and CESAC) will explain how to improve farm biosecurity through two successful SMs in their two countries: **participatory approach** (focus group) and **Biopon Programme** respectively.
